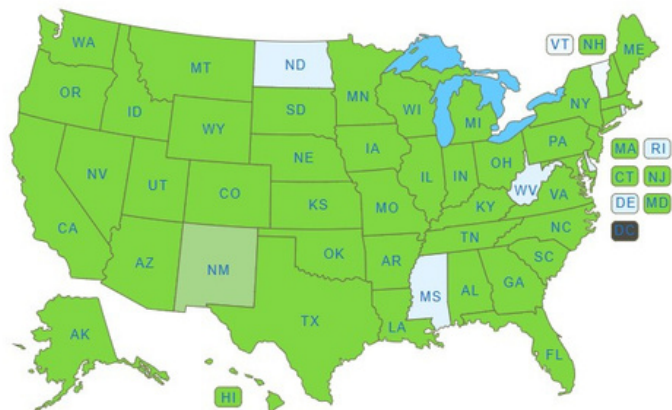

Your State of the Union Assembly

The Peacekeeping Task Force (PKTF) provides a coordinated framework for recognizing and affirming the standing of Land and Soil jurisdiction States throughout the States of America, as well as those Union States that have demonstrated lawful composition and clear civic purpose at the soil level. It is through a genuine caring observation, documentation, and networking service verification that the PKTF works to identify those American State Assemblies made up of lawful individuals committed to restoring their lawful American government structures in a responsible and orderly manner.

These assemblies are distinguished by their adherence to peaceful civic engagement, lawful conduct, and transparent organizational practices. This work is essential in bringing clarity to a landscape where misunderstandings and mischaracterizations can easily arise. By establishing consistent recognition standards, the Peacekeeping Task Force helps ensure that properly formed assemblies are not confused with groups that may operate outside acceptable legal or civic boundaries. This distinction reinforces confidence among communities and supports cooperation between assemblies working toward common lawful objectives.

A primary mission of the PKTF is the accurate identification and acknowledgment of each American State Assembly. This step is vital so that all States might advance in an organized and unified fashion, gaining appropriate recognition from their respective de facto service counterparts. Such recognition supports functional communication, mutual coordination, and the continued development of stable, lawful governance across the Union.



SELF GOVERNANCE

Self-governance means stepping out of the commercial, admiralty-based system that treats people as “persons” (artificial entities in contracts) and returning to the natural-law status of a free, responsible individual or community.

- **Authority comes from the living person, not from government or corporate “persons.”**
- **Jurisdiction is based on land, sea, and air, not on birth-certificate “persons.”**
- **Self-governance implies personal responsibility and lawful remedy.**

LOCAL COUNTY NEWS REPORTING - PIVOTAL

The importance of local press established in every county - at least two or three independent and American Free Press newsrooms - cannot be overemphasized!

During the early to mid-20th century, it was widely known that nearly 30,000 local American newspapers existed across all American counties. This fact meant that at least 30,000 opinions - all shared with their local population and visitors collectively, from a known trusted news source - informed the public what was taking place within their communities.

Unlike today, where people are bombarded with a digital media blitz from every direction except locally, there is a yearning to bring back what local print carries, which is an extremely impactful source for community awareness and confirmation of what is being reported.

We simply must consider bringing back the local press from reliable sources before none is left.



250th American Family Reunion



The Declaration of Independence was America's lawful break from British rule and the foundation of self-governance by the States of the Union. As the nation nears the 250th anniversary in Philadelphia, Americans are called to remember whether the Declaration's promises were truly carried forward.

The American States Assemblies Family Reunion in September 2026 is more than a gathering; it is a deliberate reconnection among the people of the several States, restoring the original understanding of the Declaration as a compact among sovereign States and the people. Such a reunion is urgent and healing: reclaiming July Fourth's living meaning, reasserting the States' role in preserving freedom, and rebuilding civic bonds that make self-government possible.

In Philadelphia, where independence was declared, gathering as a family of States and their people at America's 250th underscores the States as the foundation of true American liberty and guardians of the Declaration's original promise. This reunion honors the Declaration's intent in the present, not just the past. It is a moment to remember that the Declaration - alive and well - was never meant to be a distant historical artifact, but a living compact between the States, calling each generation to stand for the same principles of local sovereignty, popular consent, and lawful independence that were first proclaimed in 1776.

AMERICAN COMMON LAW & PEACE-BUILDING QUESTIONS

Inquiries within this realm of self-governing obligation are always a great opportunity to discuss among other fellow peacekeepers and peace-builders, as these roles and responsibilities remain centered in the hearts and minds of all true American families. These daily efforts should also be considered a light burden to bear in the larger scheme of things, as such obligations are so routine that they seem to become second nature to all freedom-loving people from all around the earth. Below are just a few...

1 What is the first step in maintaining a healthy working relation with all American peacekeepers at every level of service?

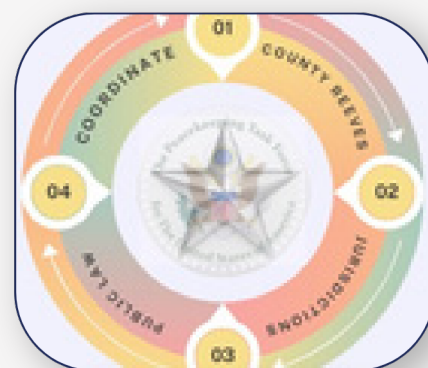
Clear, timely communication through the proper, established channels is the key to a strong connection with all peacekeepers and peace-builders at every level.

2 Regarding the handling of evidence of potential conflict or crime, what are the two service entities that ideally handles such exhibits?

For noncriminal evidence, such exhibits are provided to the organization's Ombudsman service. For possible criminal evidence, such exhibits are typically provided to the local Sheriff.

3 What is the main purpose of a Federation Liaison - among those designated "peace-builders" in the service of assisting networking?

A Federation Liaison dedicated to maintaining open lines of emergency service communication between their own State of the Union and Union State members is a Peacekeeping Task Force Liaison working to remain in service to all peacekeepers.

TIP 2

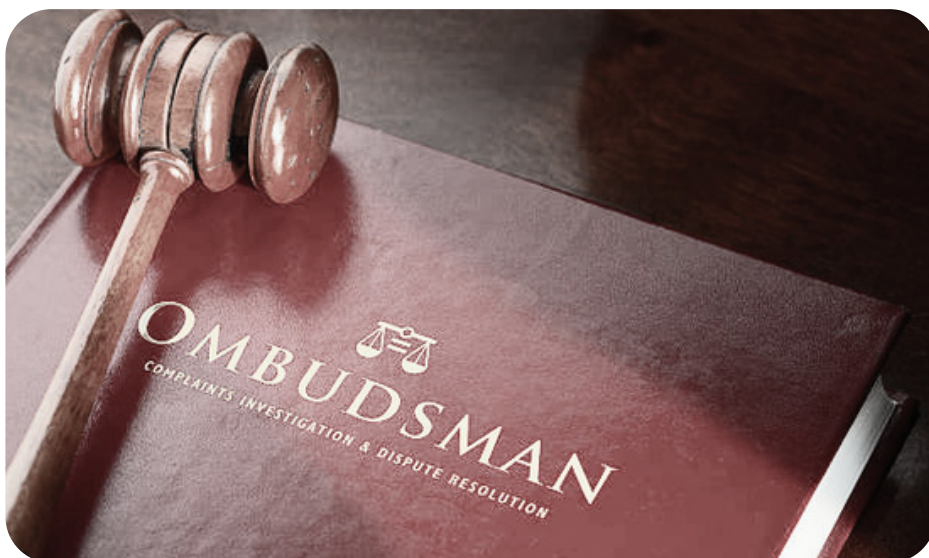
Article Focus Tip:

Assembly Wellness Thoughts

The ombudsman is a neutral, independent, and lawful representative appointed to investigate complaints, mediate disputes, and protect individuals from unfair treatment by government or organizations.

Rooted in Swedish governance in 1809 and later perfected by American utilization of such services, the role was created to ensure that public officers and officials acted in accordance with the law and to safeguard people against maladministration and potential abuse of power.

For Americans focused on American Common Law and civil status, the ombudsman serves as a critical mechanism for general accountability, transparency, and justice.

All States of the Union and their Union States that establish this vital conflict resolution service will undoubtedly avoid a significant volume of the daily setbacks that make up assembly work.

THE OMBUDSMAN WAY

Designed to shield your General Assembly from avoidable, non-criminal conflicts, with the ability to produce results in a proper and timely manner - The Ombudsman Way might be just what is needed.

Resurgence Pulse Report

Americans born on American soil hold a sovereign birthright status and inheritance that has been obscured for generations. The Federation of States, doing business as The United States of America, unincorporated in 1776, has reclaimed Americans' birthright and recovered financial assets purloined by corrupt governmental services corporations operating under territorial and municipal charters. The current U.S. government has operated in breach of the original Constitutions for over 160 years, and Americans must correct their political status to American State National in order to restore their rightful standing.

Americans are called to claim their birthright inheritance as American State Nationals and participate in State and County Assemblies to help usher in peace and prosperity. This movement is part of The American Government's Resurgence Project and the International Outreach Think Tank for the American States Assemblies, inviting commitment to the Unanimous Declaration of Independence of 1776.

Q&A ABOUT A LOCAL COUNTY GUARDIAN - SHERIFF - A DAY IN THE LIFE -

Land and Soil Service Collaboration

- Q:** Does a Soil Jurisdiction County Sheriff (Guardian) maintain a working relation with his/her State of the Union Militia Commander/Steward/Director?
- A:** **Absolutely!** In fact, both offices are a significant part of what helps maintain all known emergency services needed to safeguard State Defense Force (SDF) initiatives that apply to State Border Defense
- Q:** Can Law Enforcement Police Officers and sheriffs' deputies be conscripted into the United Nations Peacekeeping Missions if called upon to serve overseas.
- A:** **Yes.** In fact, if called upon to serve in such international peacekeeping missions, these same paramilitary and Municipal law enforcement officers (if called into service by the United Nations) cannot refuse to serve and, therefore must deploy when given the order.
- Q:** Is it true that when a State of the Union invokes Ex Parte Milligan/Milligan ex Parte for purposes of standing up their American Common Law Courts, it is the role of the Office of the Provost Marshal General (OPMG) at Army headquarters for policy-level coordination?
- A:** **Yes.** In fact, when involved in such transitions, the Office of the Provost Marshal General is notified as part of the broader coordination process where Army installations, Soldiers, or military law enforcement are affected. Still, this notification is not a stand-alone act and does not grant OPMG authority over the standing down of admiralty courts or the standing down of tribunals. However, the OPMG is a part of, but not the only department-level office to be notified in this transition notification effort.
- Q:** Does a Soil Jurisdiction Sheriff need to be in office on a County before a Continental Marshal can become available to serve in any American town or city?
- A:** **No.** A Soil Jurisdiction Sheriff does not need to be in office on a county before a Continental Marshal can serve in an American town or city; the two roles exist under separate sources of authority, service, and activation processes in the historical framework.
